

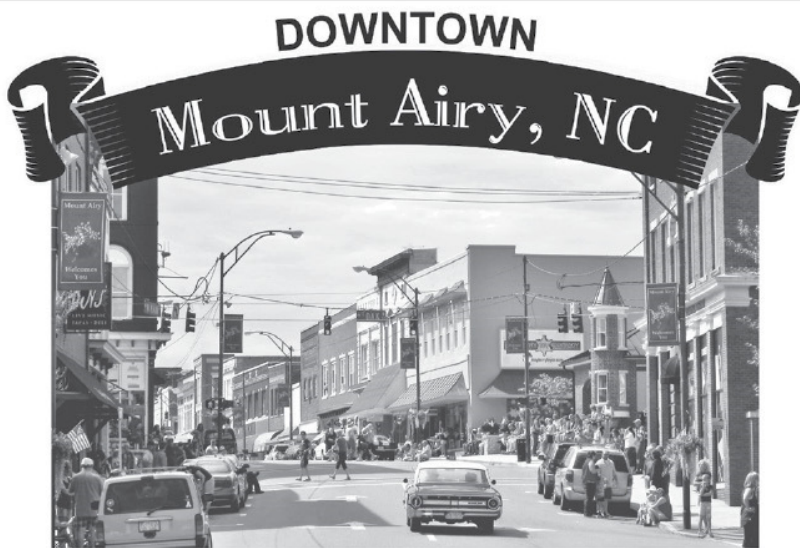

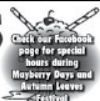

There are no refunds on purchases of any kind at any Surry Arts Council location. Jim Clark's Column

By "A Fan"

More than thirty-five Mayberry Days ago Jim Clark thought the Surry Arts Council should do a commemorative of the Andy Griffith Show. The Mayberry Days event was planned in Raleigh at the Frances Bevier estate auction. Jim Clark suggested that Doug Dillard should be invited. Doug reluctantly agreed to play for significantly less than half of his asking price, a pork chop sandwich, and a room at the Mayberry Motor Inn. He did laugh out loud at the offer. Alma and L.P. saved the day – one of the many times.

Volunteers gathered round and cleaned the old jail (the effort made USA Today), led walking tours, made slingshots for Barney's Sharpshooting, hung out dressed as Charlene (yes Mary) and more. Doug Dillard was an instant fan – sitting at the Sappy Lunch signing t-shirts – folks were bonding over and he was signing the backs of the shirts. It would be hard to the walking tours with the Moody's stop and Mr. Nelson's stories, Dink's treats at Kascob's on Market Street, the rest stop at the Bazzard's Roost – yep – that's what it was called, and a stop at Holcomb's Hardware to gather around the pot-bellied stove with Bill Holcomb telling stories about being in school with Andy. Pretty therapeutic! A trip by the jail, then on to the makeshift first visitor center with Bertie McCoy in the lobby of the Downtown Cinema followed. The tour ended at the Sappy Lunch and the barbershop. Ervin Moore sat under the portico of the Andy Griffith Playhouse just taking it all in as folks gathered for the next tour. He gave the SAC its first artifact – a slingshot that Andy's Dad made for him. Ervin was so happy the SAC was honoring Andy. Thanks to Tom Chapin who was writing an article about Andy's hometown for The Atlanta Journal-Constitution, the word about Mayberry Day got out. There was an article in the Washington Post after Mayberry Day – and then later, Kevin Sack's article made the front page of the New York Times. The articles are framed and on display.

Emmett sat back and watched it all – quietly making sure all was well with the Mayberry world and monitoring the income so one day, the SAC could build exhibits for the artifacts. He shared his Andy memorabilia collection. The exhibit moved around and landed downstairs at the Andy Griffith Playhouse. Emmett sat inside the exhibit area downstairs in the Andy Griffith Playhouse and talked with all the visitors – every day for several years. Bill Lamm led the SAC use his storefront for displaying the rocking chair, a bird cage, and other artifacts during Mayberry Days. The big scales Andy described on TAGS were right in there too. Over the years, Jim Clark was a cheerleader for an Andy Griffith Museum. When you're enjoying the Museum, just know that every word on every label was written by Jim Clark. The name of every contest during Mayberry Days was conceptualized by Jim Clark. All video clips in the Andy Griffith Museum were selected and edited by – yes – Jim Clark. There was only one location that Emmett and Andy were going to have both the statue and the Museum. It happened just the way they wanted it.

The walking tours continued and evolved into the guides hopping on buses then to official step on guides. Fan clubs offered to take over the trivia contests, the checkers contest, the horseshoe contest, and more. Fans and fan clubs continue to pitch in to make Mayberry Days even more awesome each year. More tribute artists appear each year. A few came to Mount Airy throughout the year and helped with other Arts Council events over the years. Those sweet potato dimers at Sagebrush were pretty downright special – and therapeutic. One of the fans thought Mayberry folks needed a website. He remains the official volunteer webmaster for the Surry Arts Council. Thanks to www.mayberrymatch.com, he's all in. In the 90's, a guy visited the SAC office to ask about Mayberry Days. He looked a lot like Elvis but it seems that he knew that. He came back a few weeks later for Mayberry Days. School kids had been bused to the Andy Griffith Playhouse for walking tours to learn about their community. They took the tour, filled the downtown theatre, and that Elvis guy gave them and their teachers an unforgettable concert. He's still around.

The Sappy Lunch became even more well-known than before Mayberry Days. For those who think Charles Dowell is famous only for the pork chop sandwich, just know that the fried potato cakes he put on top of the sandwiches were mmmmmmm goooooo! And the orange crush in brown bottles topped off a memorable meal. The Mayberry Days era of the pork cookers was also memorable. It was worth absolutely all of the hard work to see Elinor Donahue very seriously judging and listening to the cooks describe the rubs – and – Harvey Bullock, also known as the township judge, asking if judges were allowed to take bribes from the cooks – as he excited a tent wearing pig ears and laden with pig memorabilia. He assured the SAC that if he had known about the pigs in Mayberry, there would definitely have been a pig episode.

After 9-11, most events nationwide were cancelled. There was a lot of talk about canceling Mayberry Days but "no way" Betty Lynn and Howard Morris got on a plane in LA and flew to Charlotte. Folks came because – well – it was therapeutic. Fans sang "God Bless America" at every event that year. Andy came in 2002 for the highway dedication. He stayed in his homeplace with Cindi. He showed her the Andy Griffith Playhouse and Emmett's collection. He had lunch with Emmett and Barbara at a private home – actually it was Chang's homeplace. Andy figured out quickly that the goal of all the SAC's efforts was to keep the arts a part of Mount Airy. He and Cindi vowed to help. They did. They came back two years later with the President of TV Land and unveiled the statue of "Andy and Opie Taylor." They donated some really special artifacts to Emmett's collection for the museum.

In 2007, Betty Lynn became Mount Airy's Mayberry darling. No one ever signed more autographs or had more photographs made with fans than Betty. She possessed the true spirit of Mayberry and each and every person she met loved her. Events have grown, fans come throughout the year – not just during the annual celebration. Just spending a little time here lets folks know why many fans have moved and contribute to making Mount Airy more like Mayberry. One takes beautiful photographs – the recent sunsets, one entertains in nursing and retirement homes and volunteers at lots of SAC events, one takes square dances and the list goes on. Young folks continue to learn about the best show ever on TV and thousands visit each year. Celebrating Mayberry in Mount Airy is definitely therapeutic!

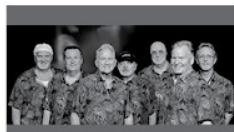

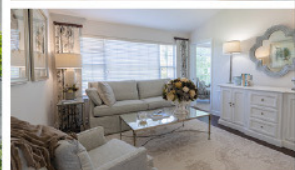
